Listed above are the team rosters and respective tee-off times. Please be on time. It is important that we do not delay the league behind us. If you know you will not be able to attend, let the others in your foursome know, so they don't wait for you. Player matches are determined by handicap. The lowest handicapped player on one team plays the lowest handicapper on the other team. If handicaps are the same, whoever had the lower handicap prior to the tie is considered the lowest. **Completion of the score card is your responsibility. This includes full names, date, and points. If a sub plays, indicate who he/she is subbing for. Turn in scorecards to John that night, or by Wednesday by scanning and emailing to John at jcnixon66@comcast.net. If you don't have a scanner, send hole by hole score and points for each player.**

Sub Rule Reminder: The only subs allowed to play are those that have registered and paid their up-front sub-fee. No points can be earned by non-official subs and non-official subs will be asked to pay the course for their round of golf. **NOTE: Subs are not allowed on Position/Championship Nights. Try to arrange pre-play for that night's round - either alone or the entire foursome.**

Absentee Points: Like previous years, you can earn points even if you don't show-up and don't have a sub. You don't get the bonus points (4) but you can earn hole-by-hole points. To calculate, add 6 strokes to your handicap, consider that your total score. Spread that total across the 9 holes as indicated by "par" and "handicap" ratings on card. That's your "absentee" round. Calculate points as if you were there (except for bonus points). If you want to get credit for your "absentee" points, it is your responsibility to get the score card from your opponent, calculate your points, and forward to John.

Special Nights: The first night is for establishing your handicap, no points are earned. This score, along with your last year's average will be your starting handicap. If you didn't play last year, this will be the only score used to compute your handicap. Plus, there are 5 event nights. But, only two (2-person Scramble & 2-person Best Ball) change normal play and aren't for points or handicap.

* **Most putts** - The winner has the most total putts. Putts are considered any shot taken on the green - not from the fringe.

* **2-person Scramble** - You and your partner play as a 2-person scramble team. It is handicapped (average of the 2 handicaps). No points this night.

* **Long-Drive** - The winner will have the longest drive that lands in the fairway on the designated hole (last group, **please** pickup the proximity marker).

* **Long Putt** - The winner has the longest putt. Putts are considered any shot taken on the green - not from the fringe.

* **NEW! 2-person BAS (Best Ball/Alternate Shot/Scramble)** - You and your partner play as a 2-person team - playing the first 3 holes as Best Ball, the next 3 holes Alternate Shot (choose 1 person to tee off and next shot is the partner's. Whomever holed the putt, other partner will tee off) and the final 3 holes as a Scramble. The best score on each hole goes on your score card. It is handicapped (average of the 2 handicaps). Scores are not counted towards your handicap, and no points are awarded.

* **Position Nights** - Determines first and second half winners. The team currently in 1st place plays the team in 2nd. And, so on. Tee-off rotation is in that order - except Team VanderMeer (and their opponents) go first so they can to start the grill, etc.

* **Grand Championship** - The winners of the 1st half play the winners of the 2nd half for the Grand Championship. The rest of the league will play a fun round of golf. The tee-off order will be: Peter/Frank vs "anyone whoever is ready". We go first so I can setup for the food and prizes. Next to tee-off is the championship foursome. Then the rest of the league - who are just playing for the fun of it. Feel free to make wagers among yourselves. There are no pre-assigned pairings for the rest of the league, just find another team to play with. The year's prizes will be awarded after play.

Note: Events/prizes and year-end banquet are reserved for league members only.
